Mt. Crested Butte Performing Arts Center Board Engages Next Steps in Design & Financing

Crested Butte Performing Arts Center (MCBPAC) Board of Directors is excited to announce that it has authorized the Design Committee to spend the necessary funds to finalize a schematic design and develop a firm construction budget for the Biery-Witt Center (BWC). “The successes of 2015 have continued into 2016, and we are now able to proceed to the next phase of the project.
